



### Reporting Outside Hockey

If you are concerned that a young person could be being abused outside the hockey environment



If the young person requires immediate medical attention, call an ambulance and inform the doctor there is a child welfare concern



Report your concerns to your Club Welfare Officer who will refer the matter to the MHA Welfare Officer to refer the matter to the Local Authority Children's Social Care Department or the Police without delay. A record must be made of anything the child has said or what you have seen, with dates and times if possible



If the Club Welfare Officer is not available refer to MHA Welfare Officer or EHB Lead Welfare Officer. If either of these are not available refer to LA Children's Social Care Department or the Police without delay



Take advice from LA Children's Social Care Department or the Police whether it is appropriate to discuss the matter with parents



Complete an EHB safeguarding referral form, copy it to the relevant external agency and the MHA Welfare Officer and the EHB Lead Welfare Officer
